Instructions to Completing the Power of Attorney (POA) for Electronic Export Information (EEI) - U.S. Principal Party in Interest (USPPI)

The purpose of this Power of Attorney to Transmit Electronic Export Information is to provide **Southwest International Customs Services LLC** with the authority to transmit EEI (formally referred to as SED) data on behalf of the U.S. Principal Party in Interest (USPPI) to the Automated Export System (AES).

United States Principal Party in Interest (USPPI) is the person or company in the U.S. that receives the primary benefit, monetary or otherwise, of the export transaction. Generally, that person - company is the U.S. seller, manufacturer or order party.

- 5.- Only an officer of the corporation may sign the POA for EEI filing

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Know all men by these presents, that (1) _____ the USPPI organized and doing business under the laws of the State or Country of (2) _____ and having an office and place of business at (3) _____ hereby authorizes **Southwest International Customs Services LLC** of 1927 Spur 239, Del Rio, TX. 78840, to act for and on its behalf as a true and lawful agent and attorney of the U.S. Principal Party in Interest (USPPI) for, and in the name, place, and stead of the USPPI, from this date, in the United States either in writing, electronically, or by other authorized means to: act as authorized agent for export control, U.S. Census Bureau (Census Bureau) reporting, and U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) purposes. Also, to prepare and transmit any Electronic Export Information (EEI) or other documents or records required to be filed by the Census Bureau, CBP, the Bureau of Industry and Security, or any other U.S. Government agency, and perform any other act that may be required by law or regulation in connection with the exportation or transportation of any goods shipped or consigned by or to the USPPI, and to receive or ship any goods on behalf of the USPPI

The USPPI hereby certifies that all statements and information contained in the documentation provided to Southwest International Customs Services LLC and relating to exportation is true and correct. Furthermore, the USPPI understands that civil and criminal penalties may be imposed for making false or fraudulent statements or for the violation of any United States laws or regulations on exportation.

The USPPI agrees to be bound by and liable for all statements of Southwest International Customs Services LLC on behalf of USPPI based upon information or documentation provided by the USPPI to Southwest International Customs Services LLC.

This power of attorney (POA) is to remain in full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given by the USPPI and received by Southwest International Customs Services LLC.
